Two of his disciples were standing by, so when John pointed out Jesus they followed Jesus - one of the two was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother - so Andrew first found Simon Peter and brought him to Jesus.

Right here you see one of the processes by which the church is to grow and to be perpetuated. we see Christ - we follow Him and then bring some one else to Him. 3

we have many people whose business it is to keep things -

1. House keepers - She is to keep it in order
2. Book keepers - To be correct when auditors come
3. Time keepers - But very few secret keepers

- Here was a man who still believed that he was his brother's keeper -

I think it is a very fine sign when a person begins to clean up his own life and that of his family first. Then having the loge stick of wood out of his own eye and the eyes of his family - they will all see more clearly how to get the mote out

of other peoples eyes

any one in the keeping business wants to know the best way to do it. This man in our lesson gets up on the best way - the best plan known to man. When you desire to keep your brethren best you can never do better than to carry him to Jesus - that is what Andrew did - The world has always been richer because of his doing -

we do not read that he brought him to a saloon - or to a road house - Bull party - or to atheism - agnosticism - but he brought him to TRUTH-LIFE the WAY - He brought him to Jesus.

Down through the Christian era men have been brought to Jesus -

1. They brought little children to Jesus and he took them in his arms put his hands upon them and blessed them -
2. They brought all manner of sick people to him for healing - Even tore an opening in a roof to let one man down before Jesus.
3. Those possessed of devils were brought before Him. Demon possessed find healing no where else for there is none other name where by man must be saved -

I do not know any better way for you to keep your brother man than to take him to Jesus -

I know no better way for you to keep him honest in his dealings with human creatures than to take him to Christ.

there is no better way to keep a man temperate in his body than to have the Christ contact.

there is no way as effective as keeping a man faithful to high and lofty principles - as bringing him to Christ - "and he brought him to Jesus!"

now let us ask - what is implied in bringing one to Jesus?

1. personal preparation on your part.
2. Finding your brother
3. So convince the brother that Christ is available that he will desire to come -
4. then set the day and hour and bring him
