ex of this is Gandhi + British Empire

the minority rallies around it there is the
beginning of victory". when a man
joins the church he moves over into
that Creative minority that is bent on
saving the world.

The church within the church is
where the power lies. Just a few

Paul - "we are a colony of heaven"
when Rome wanted to Romanize a pro-
vince she planted a colony in the
midst of it. There is a powerful minority
they stood for { Rome - law
" Justice

Christianity was powerful in those days - stopped "Inquisition"
"Glorious Revolution"

we need not only the minority Pauls
Calvary to pioneer but also Isa's rem-
nant to preserve old sanctities when
others are discarding them.
