People like to see a spectacle..they rush to pageant to the publicized movie. But here in Revelation we have the greatest spectacle of them all..the drama of the ages, the struggle between good and evil, between the Church and the world. The players for the Church are God, Christ, the holy angels. and redeemed men. On the side of evil the devil and his angels.

As page after page is turned we catch the noise of the battle and see the struggles of the contending armies. The one through whom we are enabled to see these things is John a prisoner on Patmos. As the VISION opens John sees Christ standing in the midst of the seven candle sticks and He gives to John a message to each of the seven churchs:

Then the heavens open and Johnsees the following:

GREAT THRONE...GIRT WITH A RAINBOW...GUARDED BY SEVEN LAMPS...WHICH.ARE THE SEVEN SPIRITS OF GOD....FOUR BEASTS HAVING THE FACE OF A CALF, A LION...A MAN AND AN EAGLE.

A SEVEN SEAL BOOK...NO ONE WORTHY TO OPEN IY. CHRIST OPENS IT. FIRST SEAL...WHITE HORSE...VICTORIOUS OME WENT FORTH SECOND " ...RED HORSE...WAR THIRD " ...BLACK HORSE...FAMINE FOURTH " ...BLACK HORSE...FAMINE FOURTH " ...PALE HORSE DEATH FIFTH " SOULS OF MARTYRS IN WHITE APPEAR BEFORE GOD SIXTH " EARTHQUAKE STARS FALLING FROM HEAVEN SEVENTH " SILENCE FOR HALF AN HOUR.

AFTER THE PAUSE IN THE HISTORY OF THE WORLD SEVEN ANGELS STAND BEFORE GOD.

1. Anti-Christian theories, and systems of government where people are promised "the better life" without regard to different talents....Communionism.

Millions in Korea and China saw golden crowns in the promises Communionism made them but they turned out to have a sting in their tail.

Such is held up by the Southern Baptist Convention, the Presbyterian Assembly, and thus some of the Bishops and some of the higher ups in the WSCS of our church as crowns of gold never realizing the sting it is bound to bring when we take such as political expedency and go against God's plan for racial purity and integrity. THE APPLES OF GOLD THEY THINK WILL COME WILL TURN OUT TO TO BE APPLES OF SODOM.
