METHODISM.

I know of no community where Methodism has advanced more this year than in Greenville.

The first three years of this quadrennium before Trinity church was organized Greenville Methodism received into the church by profession and otherwise a total of 321. That was total for three years.

During this fourth year of the quadrennium, since Trinity was organized 330 have been received or nine more than was received for the three years preceding the new organization. The budget of Methodism increased in Greenville this year over \$10,000 to say nothing of money raised by both churches for building purposes.

Our neighboring towns of Greenwood and Clarksdale, where there is but one church to the town, might take note and go back home and begin an expansion program for Methodism in those fine communities.
