Here in Daniel 9:24 we read of a winding up, a finishing of a great piece of work. The 70 weeks spoken of in this chapter mean 490 weeks of years or 490 years from the time the conqueror had went forth to restore and build Jerusalem. Beginning here 457 B.C. it ended 33 A.D. making the prophecy literally come true.

Let us look into the prophecy. Several was one determined upon my people and upon thy holy city to finish the transgression,

and to make and end of sins and make reconciliation for iniquity and to bring in everlasting righteousness and to seal up the vision and prophecy and to anoint the most Holy.

1. To finish the transgression i.e. restrain it which was done by the beginning to preach the gospel and by the pouring out of the Holy Ghost.
2. To make an end of sins. i.e. to make and end of sin offerings
3. To make reconciliation
4. To bring in everlasting righteousness or "the Righteous One of ages."
5. To seal up the vision and prophecy, i.e. put an end to further necessity for further revelation and to finish the Bible as to the facts that were to be contained in it regarding the prophecy concerning His Person, sacrifice, and glory.
6. Anoint the most Holy: The appointment of Christ as Prophet, Priest, and King of mankind.

According to the very best Authority it was exactly 490 yrs. to the month from the time Ezra had his commission to restore and rebuild Jerusalem to the time when Jesus on the Cross said, "It is finished" Finished! not only the prophecy but the plan and thank God — the suffering of my Lord.
